

# Epitaph with Latin inscription for Lucius Decrius Abascantus



## Subject

Epitaph bearing an inscription in Latin for Lucius Decrius Abascantus (CIL VI.16795).

You read: D Â· M L Â· DECRIOL Â· L Â· L Â· ABASCANTO.

Transliteration: D(is) M(anibus) L(ucio) Decrio L(uci) l(iberto) Abascanto.

Translation: â€œTo Manes. For Lucius Decrius Abascantus, freedman of Luciusâ€•.
