Subject

Epitaph bearing an inscription in Latin for Attia Asclepias (CIL VI.12759).

You read: D · M/ ATTIAE/ ASCLEPIADI.

Transliteration: D(is) M(anibus) Attiae Asclepiadi.

Translation: “To the spirits of the deceased. To Attia Asclepias”.
