Fragments of polychrome plaster representing portions of human figures, an Eros or a winged putto, a fish and a ship's prow.

Plaster, fresco technique

Fragmentary; 28 fragments are preserved

Estimation of the original dimension: 2x1 m.

Late 3rd-4th cent. A.D. ?
